

Outdoor banner.

Space visible/image area (for original production):

32 525 mm x 9 750 mm.

Production dimensions (including construction):

32 525 mm x 9 750 mm.

Material (All material must be fire-classified):

Mesh. B1 flammability class as per DIN 4102.

Construction:

Reinforced polyester tape and o-rings (500 mm c/c) along all vertical sides as well as reinforced keder at the top and bottom. Extra reinforcement and straps on all corners on all sections to withstand heavy loads and wind.

The banner shall be printed in five sections according to appendix and shall be marked in each corner (upper right, lower left etc.).

Packaging and marking: (Folded like a sail)

The material must be clearly marked with the advertiser, campaignperiod, subject and indexnumber, as well as a picture of the subject. The material must also be clearly marked with the airport contact person.

Production:
